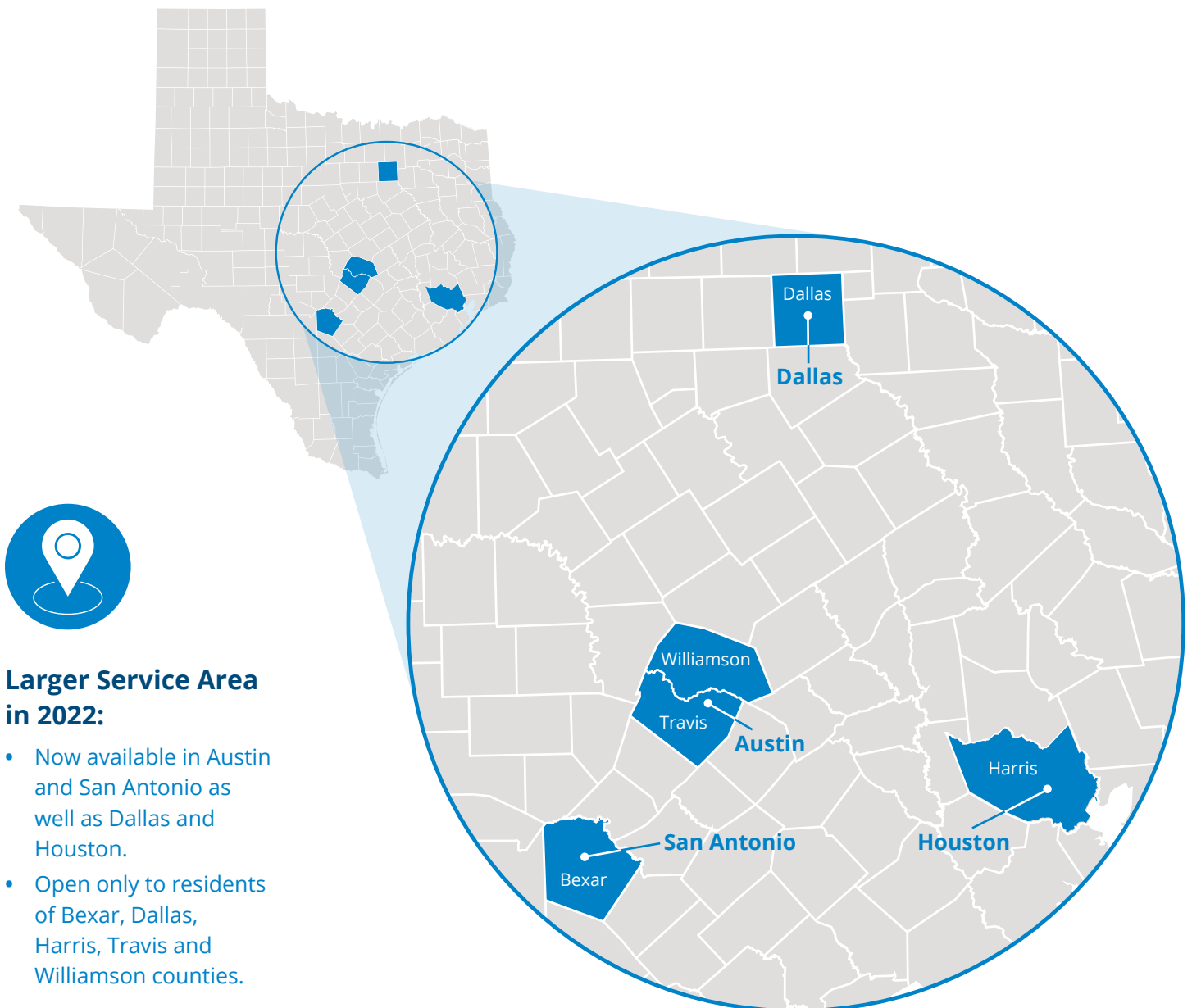


MyBlue Health is expanding into new areas for 2022.

Now serving the greater Austin and San Antonio markets, along with Dallas and Houston.



Larger Service Area in 2022:

- Now available in Austin and San Antonio as well as Dallas and Houston.
- Open only to residents of Bexar, Dallas, Harris, Travis and Williamson counties.



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MyBlue Health network details:

- There are three plans available: Bronze, Silver and Gold
- Network consists of approximately 27 hospitals and 6,594 providers¹
- Members must choose a Select Primary Care Physician (PCP) from the county they live in, but they will be able to see them at any of the Select PCP's locations.
- Retail members who choose a Select PCP will have a \$0 copay for any scheduled visit with that Select PCP.

Preferred Medical Group by County:

- **Dallas & Harris** – Sanitas Medical Centers
- **Bexar** – Centro Med as well as independent community physicians
- **Travis/Williamson** – CommUnity Care, Lone Star Circle of Care, and independent community physicians



Members also receive \$0 copay for the following services at MyBlue Health network clinics²

- Scheduled Select PCP office visit
- Certain X-rays, ultrasounds, ECGs
- Testing for allergies
- Minor in-office procedures, such as biopsy, wart removal, etc.
- Select immunizations and their administration
- Chronic disease management programs
- Health education programs and wellness services
- Mental and behavioral health office visits
- Telehealth
